WHAT ON EARTH IS WORM FARMING?

It's a simple, natural way of composting food scraps and garden waste into a rich organic soil improver, perfect for boosting veggie and plant growth. Read on to find out more!



WHY WORM FARMING?

FIGHT FOOD WASTE, MAKE PLANT FOOD

Each year in Australia **5 million tonnes of food waste** ends up as landfill, creating a huge environmental issue and costing the economy \$20 billion! **Half of that food waste is from households.** Once in landfill, food and organic waste decomposes anaerobically, releasing gases toxic to the natural environment.

Worm farming (also called vermiculture), is a great way to reduce household food waste, which takes up as much as 35% of your bin. Worms will eat your food and garden waste and naturally convert them into worm castings full of nutrients. You can then add the castings to soil or potting mix to feed your veggies and plants.



WORMS LOVE TO EAT:

- ✓ most food scraps
- ✓ coffee grounds
- ✓ ground-up eggshells
- ✓ garden waste like weeds, bark, leaves, broken sticks
- ✓ pre-composted animal manures

WORMS DON'T LIKE:

- ✗ dairy, meat, bread, rice, pasta
- ✗ acidic foods like, citrus, tomatoes
- ✗ onion, garlic, pawpaw and pineapples
- ✗ oil, grease, vinegar, chilli

Compost these in your bokashi bin.



CREATE NATURAL PLANT FERTILISER

Continuous use of synthetic fertilisers damages the natural biology of soil, resulting in soil degradation and requiring the use of more fertiliser to get the same result. Synthetic fertilisers can also lead to serious water contamination issues when they leach into groundwater and water courses.

Worm castings, and their liquid derivative worm tea, can help reduce synthetic fertiliser use, allowing degraded soil to rejuvenate. Both worm castings and tea are fantastic sources of naturally occurring soil biology such as healthy bacteria and fungi, which help retain soil structure and allow plants to extract existing soil nutrients in plant-soluble form.

SUSTAINABLE, ORGANIC PESTICIDE

Like synthetic fertilisers, synthetic pesticides leach into waterways, affecting land environments and accumulating in the ocean's food chain.

Choosing to use natural pesticides like worm tea helps combat pests and diseases sustainably. As a natural resource, worm tea and castings work with plant roots to produce a healthy, sustainable plant ecosystem that strengthens the plant to resist disease and parasites. You can also spray worm tea directly on the plant leaves to deal with a range of pests, right up to time of harvest.

FEED THE WORMS

Feed your food scraps and garden waste to the compost worms. Worms convert them into castings, full of nutrients, healthy bacteria and fungi.



ADD CASTINGS TO SOIL

Dig worm castings into your veggie garden or potting soil. Feed your plants with worm tea and apply it to leaves to keep diseases and pests away.



CASTINGS IMPROVE SOIL

The improved soil biology helps your plants grow larger roots, making them healthier, more productive, and more resistant to pests and disease.
